(INSTRUMENTALISTS)**

(Performance Instrument) 480 Graduate Performance course (for first semester)* 4 hours

MUS 398D Artist Recital (for second and subsequent semesters) 9 hours

Artist Recitals: 3 recitals with a choice between these two options: Solo option – two solo recitals (a complete concerto must be included in one of the solo recitals) and one chamber music recital; or the Chamber recital option - two chamber recitals and one solo recital. Two of the recitals must be presented on the UT-Austin campus or in metropolitan Austin, and one at a venue outside of the metropolitan Austin area.

ENS 18x: Problems in Performance Practice (each semester) 4 hours

Piano students must enroll in MUS 180T: Accompanying.

MUS 181D: Chamber Music (each semester) 4 hours

Six semester hours of upper-division or graduate level courses,
not including those listed above. 6 hours

Students are encouraged to take courses appropriate to their area, such as literature, pedagogy, or specialized techniques.

Total: 27 hours

* A qualifying jury must be performed at end of first semester of study.
