Musicology students are required to pass a language proficiency examination in one language other than English – normally German, French, or Spanish – by petition to the Division. The language requirement should ideally be fulfilled by the end of the second semester of residence.

A comprehensive examination is required of all Master's degree candidates, usually in the final semester of study.
